



DISSEMINATION WORKSHOP SUMMARY
A REVIEW OF CRIME AND CRIMINAL JUSTICE IN
TANZANIA

AHSI co-hosted the dissemination event with the Legal and Human Rights Centre in Tanzania at the Kempinski Hotel in Dar es Salaam on the 25th of March 2009. A total of 64 participants attended the workshop which was also a validation exercise of the review report that was compiled by a team of Tanzanian researchers. The audience was representative of all the criminal justice institutions in the country as well as key organisations working on legal issues.

The APRM office was represented by the acting chief executive, Ms Rehema Twalib who urged other local organizations to make submissions/contributions such as the draft AHSI had submitted to her offices.

Key issues from the event were:

- a. The participants all concurred on the erratic collection and recording of crime data by the police. The quality of police training was also identified as an issue that requires scrutiny.
- b. The increased criminalization of political activity in the country was a cause for concern and civil society groups expressed a desire for this to be reflected in the report.
- c. Though the country acknowledges its corruption problems amongst high ranking officials, the participants pointed out the need to study private

sector corruption too as this was deemed to outweigh the current levels of public sector corruption.

- d. The audience pointed out the need to include a review of Zanzibar's criminal justice system. This is essential because the regime recognizes Islamic/Sharia law which is not recognized by the mainland.
- e. The audience pointed out the need to come up with indicators of any observed increase of access to justice that is a direct result of any reforms.
- f. The methodology of the review triggered many questions and it was suggested that the report be expanded to be more inclusive of the rest of the country.
